





On the peninsula:

- The routes may vary depending on the driver. This means they DO NOT ALWAYS pass the PC office.
- Sometimes Mwenge-Posta marked dalas run this route
- The northern portion of the route is a one-way loop

Safety and Security Notes:

- Do NOT stay in hotels in the Kariakoo district.
- Walking along Toule Dr. (on the peninsula) is very dangerous
- Do not take pictures of government buildings.

Easy route from Econolodge to Posta

At Posta:

- Ubungo, G/Mboto, and Rangi Tatu dalas make a loop but the exit routes may vary for each dala
- Ferries to Zanzibar and Pemba are located next to the Kivukoni dala stand
- Masaki dala passes Posta then turns around at the next round-about and travels out the same street
- Posta dalas do not stop at the Kivukoni stand
